

Trinity Prep School Athletic Requirements

Below is the Academic Policy designated by the conference of The Georgia Association of Private & Parochial Schools, commonly referred to as GAPPS that Trinity Prep School requires all students who participate in sports to abide by.

Representation: Students are held to a high standard as they represent God, their families, and Trinity Prep School in every action, including what they post on Social Media. It is at the discretion of Administration of proper expectations of representation.

In order to participate in any sports offered under the Athletic Department of Trinity Prep School, the following is required of the student:

Academic Requirements: The student must obtain a passing grade of 70 or higher in three of the four classes they are currently taking. In addition, the student must maintain a GPA of 2.5 for their CORE classes, including Math, Science, Language, and Social Studies. The grade report will be processed each game day. The dual enrollment students are required to visit the High School office prior to 8:15 on the morning of a game to present their dual enrollment grade for calculation.

Behavior: Students should follow all behavior requirements that are outlined in the handbook.

Please refer to the Handbook for detailed expectations of the students. It is by his deeds that a lad distinguished himself, if his conduct is pure and right. (Proverbs 20:11)

In all areas of learning, discipline must be considered in the development of children. The Code of Conduct is based on the Gospel message of Jesus. Growth in self-discipline, responsibility for Christian values, and a loving respect for the rights of all persons is encouraged and nourished by the Code of Conduct. To achieve these goals, parents, staff, and children must work together.

Based upon moral values and loving respect for other children each player:

- 1. Will be truthful
- 2. Maintain a GPA of 2.5 or higher and keep a grade of 70 or higher in 3 of the 4 classes taken
- 3. Will keep social media, text and outside activities clean and refrain from foul language, drugs or other things that could give a negative appearance to your character
- 4. Will be respectful and courteous toward all teachers and adults
- 5. Will refrain from harassment of any kind
- 6. Will use appropriate language
- 7. Will speak respectfully to and about others
- 8. Will respect all school and personal property
- 9. Will play with good sportsmanship and cooperation
- 10. Will respect the flag, Bible and this amazing country by standing for pledges, US anthem and prayers

Students are not allowed to play in games or practice if they have ISS or OSS on that day or if they do not meet the Academic Requirements, but they are required to attend the game or practice and sit with their team.
